Current legal basis

- Ordinance on Addressing Resources in the Telecommunications Sector (OARTS)
- Delegation of tasks to third parties
- Offerings to end customers
- Wholesale offering
- Regulated prices and contractual conditions



Revision of the ordinance

- Ordinance on Internet Domains (OID)
- Domains .ch and .swiss
- Common and specific provisions
- Consultation procedure until 17 April 2014
- Entry into force no later than 1 January 2015



Aspects of future regulation

- Separation of registry and registrar functions
- Registry .ch: delegation of tasks
- Registrars: registrar contract
- No price regulation at retail level
- Commitment to offer just a .ch domain name



Registry

- Delegation of tasks according to public procurement procedures
- Management, allocation of the right of use
- Independence
- No retail business
- Contractual obligation with registrars



Transitional law

- Extension of contract with SWITCH until max. mid-2018
- Existing partner agreements: inventory and adaptation
- SWITCH end customer relationships:
 - No new end customers
 - Extension of contract term
 - Migration to registrars
