SOURCES ARE KNOWN TO THEM. THEY RESPECT THE
PRIVACY OF INDIVIDUALS, UNLESS THE PUBLIC INTEREST DEMANDS
OTHERWISE. THESE ARE RULES FROM THE JOURNALISTS CODE. MEDIA
PROFESSIONALS UNDERTAKE TO COMPLY
WITH THEM. THEIR WORK IS IMPORTANT FOR A
FUNCTIONING DEMOCRACY.
