## **Telecommunications Statistics**

Description	Telecommunications statistics have been collected and published since 1998 in order to
	evaluate telecommunications legislation, take the necessary regulatory decisions and
	monitor the universal service <sup>1</sup> .
	Available since: 1998
	Statistical population: Telecommunication services providers (TSP) or infrastructure providers.
	Main variables: Infrastructure, players, customers, usage and prices, particularly for fixed
Methodology	and mobile networks.
	Comprehensive survey of around 500 companies by means of an online questionnaire (Survalyzer).
	Degree of regionalisation: Switzerland
	Frequency: Anually
	Reference period: Full year or last month of the year.
Legal basis	Art. 59 para. 2 of the Telecommunications Act of 30 April 1997 (TCA; SR 784.10), specifying
	the obligation on persons subject to the TCA to provide complete, accurate and timely
	statistics.
	Art. 59 para. 2ter states that the Federal Office of Communications (OFCOM) may publish
	information on market shares.
	Ordinance on Telecommunications Services (OTS; SR 784.101.1), Arts. 97 ff.
	Federal Statistics Act of 9 October 1992 (FStatA; SR 431.01).
	Ordinance of 30 April 2025 on Federal Statistics (OFStat; SR 431.011).
Revision	Routine revision (or continuous revision): Every year
	Methodological revision (or complete revision): A revision began in 2023, focusing first on
	redefining the survey framework. The questionnaire itself will also be the subject of a more
	in-depth revision by thematic block, including new methods for detecting outliers.
	Unplanned revision: No
